Easter Sunday was a blast! We had choir and specials, Easter quiz, egg hunt, and the preaching and celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ in each of our classes. A visiting couple loved the service and it gave me an opportunity to visit them the following week. The wife gave her testimony, but the husband painted a picture of religion his whole life but it wasn't personal. I gave the gospel, but he only responded with "everyone knows the story." I connected with the wife the next week about concern for her husband's spiritual security in Christ and she informed me that I wasn't invited back. I thought she would be glad that someone cared for her husband, but she desired rather for him to be left alone. Pray for this couple that the husband would get saved and the wife would have her eyes opened to the truth of God's Word.
