This past month:

Thank you for praying for our summer youth camp! With discipleship as the focus, the camp really challenged young people not to stay where they are in their faith but to keep growing—following Jesus more closely, becoming more like Him, and encouraging others to do the same. Many from Liberty’s youth group shared how the messages spoke directly to their hearts, causing them to reflect on their own walk with the Lord. Churches from all over Chile—north, central, and south—were in attendance, bringing many teenagers, including several who had only recently started coming to church. **Praise the Lord, five young people put their faith in Jesus, and many others made commitments to follow Christ more wholeheartedly!** It was an incredible week, and I’m grateful for how God worked!

I recently met Pilar, a kind-hearted retiree, at the English class we’re offering at Peace Baptist Church. She’s been faithfully attending for several weeks now. One Tuesday, as we wrapped up the lesson and reviewed Romans 5:8, she shared how much she enjoys not only the English classes but also hearing and reading the Bible verses in English during the short devotionals at the end of each class. Would you pray with me for Pilar? **Pray that God would open her eyes to see that these verses aren’t just words but His words for her.** She’s expressed interest in attending the Wednesday services at Peace Baptist in the coming weeks—please pray that she takes that step and that God continues working on her heart!

When we go on outreach at Liberty, we usually pair up in twos or threes and head out with a map marking our assigned route for knocking on gates or conducting surveys. One Saturday, a young lady and I misread our map and ended up handing out tracts in the "wrong" area. Thankfully, God used our mistake to lead us to a cheerful woman walking down the street named Yanira, who seemed genuinely interested in the tract we gave her and in the church. She came to the evening service the very next Sunday and raised her hand during the invitation. While Yanira is already saved, she has a lot of questions and needs discipleship. **Please pray with us that she comes back!**

At the end of February, we have a big VBS outreach planned for the community, along with a back-to-school service to kick off the new school year. Please pray that the Lord brings new people to Liberty and that we can find property to move into. We’re excited to see how God will work this year!
