We were told to vacate the property on 28th July and find different accommodations. They still plan to sell it to us, but cannot move forward until all is resolved. We were also informed that it could take months. This was unforeseen by us, but not God. We are praying for His guidance and wisdom as we seek a temporary facility until such a time as we purchase the building. Please pray with us!
