Over the past three months, we have gained an additional 8% of our needed support, bringing us to over 36%! God is truly wonderful. He has kept us safe and allowed us to visit 22 different churches. One blessing was His protection during a minor car accident (Charity was not in the vehicle). Unfortunately, our car was totaled after hitting a deer. However, the Lord quickly provided a way for us to purchase a new vehicle, and we praise Him for that.

We were also blessed to spend time with family and be in our home over the holidays in December. We are forever grateful for the love and support shown by our family and sending church; words cannot fully express our appreciation!

As we reflect on 2024, we see it as a year filled with countless blessings. First and foremost, God allowed me and Charity to get married, and I am so thankful for her! She has been an incredible help and companion. As many of you know, we started full-time deputation right after our wedding in February. This has been another blessing. Since then, we have attended over 80 services or meetings, traveled 46,343 miles, and have had meetings in 19 different states.
