#### **Launch Service**

This last month of ministry has been very exciting as we geared for the launch of the church on April 21st. We had always looked forward to the official launch of the church in April, but we really began emphasizing it within our church and to our community at the beginning of March. We began promoting it on our website as well as heavily pushing our church launch on social media through various ads and posts we ran. The big push online led me to meeting a young man named Josbin, who had just immigrated to Canada within the last year. I was able to meet up for coffee with him and answer many questions he had about the Bible and about our church since he has a big Catholic background. Since then, I have had the opportunity to meet up a couple more times. Although he has yet to come to a church service, I am thankful that a relationship is being built and trust is forming to the point where he will text me questions throughout the week about what the Bible says. Please pray for him as I continue ministering to him in the next coming months.

As soon as April came about, we began to hand out invites to our grand opening service around our neighbourhoods and the ones surrounding the church. Everyone on our ministry team, as well as our church members, really bought in and made a big effort to send personal invitations to coworkers, family members, friends, and other connections they had.

As the Launch Weekend came, we had an Open House Saturday at our church facility. Our goal was dual purpose, as it allowed us to set up the church the day before instead of Sunday morning, but we also wanted to open our doors for people to come in on a more casual setting and meet the entire ministry team outside of a Sunday service. We had about 35 people come through with about 4 of those being first time visitor who were curious about the church.

The next day, was our Launch Sunday which went just as good as we could have imagined. We had 66 people attend the service in total — about 24 of our own people, 33 from other churches in the province, and 9 visitors. We were privileged to have Pastor Robert Wall, pastor of FaithWay Baptist Church, come out and preach the Launch Service for us. He preached a great message on Christ being the head of the church, as well as the One who empowers the church.

After the service, our church members provided a meal for everyone which allowed our ministry team to connect with all the visitors. The next Sunday after the launch, we had three of the visitors come back to attend as well as a brand new family visit our service.
