Update: Holywell

Croeso cynnes i chi o Dreffynnon – A warm welcome to you from Holywell! Speaking of warm, we have had our annual allotment of 5 warm summer days here with temperatures peaking one day at 91 F; now we seem to be back to our regular high of about 70F. There is much climate hysteria over here while they seem to ignore soaring violent crime, a failing socialized health care system and state-sponsored assisted suicide is poised to pass in Parliament (what will most likely become euthanasia in the long run). The UK needs Christ – please pray for us as we continue to minister here.

We have been blessed to have several **visitors** these past months, including 2 nurses from Africa (Uganda and Zimbabwe). One young man came at the invitation of one of our members who fits precisely the characteristics of the

"Quiet Revival" occurring in the UK. He is in his mid-20s and is earnestly seeking God. He is asking a lot of questions because he "does not want to be fooled." I think he might be from Missouri originally 😊 Though he has many questions, I have been trying to get him to focus on Jesus first – that is where our walk of faith starts. Once he is spiritually alive and has the Holy Spirit, he will better understand the many other questions he has.

Carol and her daughter joined with our congregation several years ago after being wounded by several local churches. Carol suffered from chronic back pain but always had a smile on her face when she came to chapel. Carol passed to glory suddenly just after Easter. It was one of those bitter-sweet moments in ministry to perform her funeral, but also one in which I was

confident of her salvation. In a country where the gospel is seldom heard at funerals, I was able to share true hope and eternal life in her death. Please be in prayer for her daughter, Ezme, as she grieves the loss of her mother. On the heels of this, Ezme's husband suddenly took ill with sepsis (blood poisoning). After waiting over 10 hours for an ambulance to transfer him to hospital, his prognosis was not good. The sepsis had caused him to fit violently, and he had amnesia, not knowing close friends or even remembering the death of his mother-in-law. Though he and I had only met a few times (he is an atheist, though friendly), he asked for me to come by name. I will not share that conversation, except that it was concern for his family in which I shared God's concern for him. He did not accept it then but left the door open to speak more with him about his soul!

Summer events ...

Like many of you, we are gearing up for our regular UK-wide **summer camp**. When the junior camp registration deadline came none of our young people in **Fantastic Fridays!** Bible club wanted to go. It would have been something new but I was disappointed that parents did not encourage their children to go, knowing the outcome would be positive as they learned

more about God. However, our teen helper, Cai, and another teen who comes with his parents to services signed up for senior camp! Last year, Cai made a decision to follow Christ; I have shared the gospel with the teen who said he is not ready to make up his mind yet. Pray that camp has a positive impact on him understanding and committing to Christ. We continue to pray for workers

willing to take on a teen ministry; it is one thing too many for Mary and I to do alone. Perhaps, this will get some to commit.

The town council is again holding their community fair called **"Party in the Park"** in July. Last year we made over 200 balloon animals while we handed out chapel brochures and spoke to parents about the chapel. Please be in prayer for fruit from this outreach!
