This verse is a blessing and a reminder that God's will is for us to be thankful. Our hearts are full of thanksgiving as we write this letter to update you on the ministry with which God has blessed us. We are more aware than ever of the need for the Gospel in the Netherlands. Many people are steeped in religious tradition and rigorous rules, which keep them from seeing the truth of God's love and the Way of salvation, which is Jesus. We pray that the Lord will open the hearts and the eyes of the Dutch people to understand this love and the sacrifice that was made by Jesus on the cross.

One answer to prayer is the continuation of our Gospel tract ministry. Some people are willing to take the tracts from us, and others are not. We pray that the distribution of these tracts in the Dutch language will touch the hearts of the people in the communities that we visit. We are thankful to God for the opportunity to share this great news with people who are unsure if they can be saved.

We are continuing in our efforts to learn the Dutch language. Although there are many words that are similar to English words, there are many differences in grammar and other aspects of the language. This makes it difficult for native English speakers to speak some words properly. We are working each day to learn the language, as this is critical in our mission of spreading the Gospel in this country. Please pray with us that the Lord will allow us to learn the language quickly in order to share the Gospel with people in the language of their hearts.

We have had several doctors' appointments recently, which is an answer to prayer. Caroline has had appointments with a rheumatologist as well as an ophthalmologist. We prayed specifically for Caroline's eyes to be free of inflammation. Although her eyes were not completely clear, we praise the Lord that her joints seem to be clear even without the use of her normal medication for the last few months. Sabrina also had an appointment regarding her eyes. She is waiting for additional tests in order to receive what she needs in order to see more clearly.

We also had a great visit from my mother and brother and look forward to an upcoming visit from my wife's family. God has been so good to us!
