### Dear Pastor and Praying Partners,

As we look back on this past month, our hearts are full from seeing God's faithfulness here in Arequipa. November brought significant changes and new opportunities for ministry, including stepping in to provide oversight and leadership training at a sister church after a fellow missionary transitioned off the field. We also enjoyed a wonderful Thanksgiving banquet and new discipleship graduates taking important steps in their walk with Christ. Thank you for praying with us as we continue serving and trusting the Lord in each new season!

#### Ministry Update

This month has brought an important transition for our ministry as I step in to provide leadership at El Salvador Baptist Church following the departure of Mitch McCormack and his family from the field. I will be helping guide the church spiritually, offering oversight and encouragement to the leadership team, and investing intentionally in several young men who are sensing God's call to ministry. This new responsibility will require both a weekly commitment of my time in addition to Redeemer Baptist Church and additional financial resources.
